The deal expands EPAM's financial services portfolio and broadens its global footprint with the acquisition providing more than 100 new clients.

Microsoft Q125: AI continues to boost Cloud revenues

Microsoft posted a solid start to FY25 with its AI business on track to surpass an annual revenue run rate of \$10 billion next quarter, which will make it the fastest business in the company's history to reach this milestone. According to the latest stats there are now more than 3,000 AI companies in the UK, generating more than £10bn in revenues, employing more than 60,000 people in AI related roles, and contributing £5.8bn in Gross Value Added (GVA). Compared to the 2022 study, aggregate numbers of AI companies, revenues, employment and GVA are all higher in 2023.

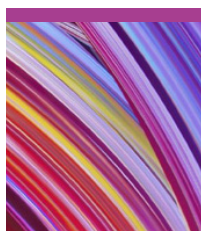

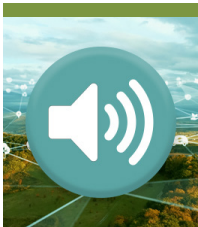




Roc targets growth via four big bets
